INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A PAPER:

1. Authors are asked to submit an abstract via email to the session organizer by January 29, 2018. Abstracts must be sufficiently detailed to allow the session organizer to judge the merits of the paper.
2. The author making the submission should provide the full names, affiliations, and e-mail addresses of all co-authors for each submission. The author who makes the submission will be treated as the corresponding author unless otherwise noted.
3. Session organizers will notify corresponding authors about acceptance of papers beginning on February 28, 2018.
4. Completed papers should be sent to session organizers by May 15, 2018.
5. Student authors who wish to submit their paper for the Student Paper Competition should submit their abstract to both the appropriate session organizer and Yoko Yoshida (yoko.yoshida@dal.ca). The Student Paper Competition committee this year is co-chaired by Dr. Yoko Yoshida and Dr. Sean Waite. Full papers are to be submitted to Yoko by April 23, 2018 in order to be considered for the Competition.
6. Authors who wish to submit their papers only for a poster session should submit their abstract directly to the Organizing Committee Chair, Lisa Strohschein (lisa.strohschein@ualberta.ca).

7. If no session is appropriate for your paper, please submit the abstract directly to the Organizing Committee Chair, Lisa Strohschein (lisa.strohschein@ualberta.ca).
8. All participants must be current members of the Canadian Population Society to participate in the CPS meeting.
9. Please make note of this new policy for 2018: At least one author of an accepted paper must register for the conference by April 10, 2018. Papers for which no author has registered by this deadline will be dropped from the final program. If you require an exemption from this policy (e.g., you are an international student who is waiting for an approved visa or have other extenuating circumstances), please email the Organizing Committee Chair, Lisa Strohschein (lisa.strohschein@ualberta.ca) well in advance of the April 10th deadline.
