The Department of Sociology invites applications for a tenure-track appointment at the Assistant Professor level, commencing July 1st, 2014 at Trent's Peterborough campus, subject to budgetary approval. We seek candidates committed to undergraduate teaching excellence and intellectual leadership in a department emphasizing critical approaches to sociological inquiry (see <http://www.trentu.ca/sociology>).

Applicants should have a Ph.D. in Sociology at the time of appointment, undergraduate teaching experience and an active record of scholarly publishing in the sociological field of health, with expertise in one or more of the following areas: sociology of medicine, health technologies, biopolitics and population health, e-health, environmental and spatial dimensions of health, cultures of health expertise, health and social inequality. The successful candidate should be prepared to teach and develop courses in one or more of the Department's core areas including introductory sociology, social research methods, and social theory, as well as courses related to their substantive field(s).

Applicants should send a curriculum vitae, a letter describing research interests and projects, copies of recent publications, a teaching portfolio (including evaluations of teaching) and the names of and contact information for three referees to Professor Deborah White, Chair, Department of Sociology ( [sociology@trentu.ca](mailto:sociology@trentu.ca) ). The review of applicants will begin on **February 18, 2014** and continue until the position is filled.
