In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic situation and based on a survey of CPS members conducted in Fall 2020, the 2021 CPS Annual Meeting will be held remotely.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A PAPER:

1. **Abstract submission deadline:** Please note that we are piloting a new, streamlined process this year with one central submission address. Session chairs will be announced in March 2021.

Authors are asked to submit **an abstract** via email to CPS.CFA2021@gmail.com by **February 1, 2021**.

Abstracts must be sufficiently detailed to allow to judge the merits of the paper and the submission must include the session theme of interest.

CPS 2021 SESSION THEMES

2. **Required information:** The author making the submission should provide: **1) the full names, 2) affiliations, and 3) e-mail addresses of all co-authors for each submission.** The author who makes the submission will be treated as the corresponding author unless otherwise noted.
3. **Students' participation:** The CPS highly encourages student members to participate. **If you are a student member and submitting an abstract for a session, please indicate your degree program** (e.g. Master's student in Sociology, etc.) along with your affiliation. Such information will help facilitate student participation and identify those eligible for the student paper competition.

The CPS is also organizing various events for students' career development. We will be sending out more information about this in the coming months.

4. **The Student Paper Competition:**
 - Students' abstracts that are accepted for presentation in the CPS conference, either in a session or as a poster, are eligible for the Student Paper Competition. Students will be notified about the eligibility to submit a paper to the Student Paper Competition. The committee is chaired by Stacey Hallman stacey.hallman@canada.ca.
 - The deadline to submit a paper to the Student Competition Committee is April 15, 2021.

 9. **Announcement of results:** Session organizers will notify corresponding authors about **acceptance of papers beginning on March 1, 2021.**
 10. **Membership requirement:** All participants must be current members of the Canadian Population Society to participate in the CPS meeting. Please make note that at least one author of an accepted paper must **register for the conference by April 15, 2021.** Papers for which no author has registered by this deadline will be dropped from the final program.

 11. **Submission of the final paper:** Completed papers should be sent to session chairs by **May 11, 2021.**
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
