INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUBMITTING A PAPER:

1. Authors are asked to submit **an abstract** via email to the session organizer **by January 31, 2019**. Abstracts must be sufficiently detailed to allow the session organizer to judge the merits of the paper.
2. The author making the submission should provide the full names, affiliations, and e-mail addresses of all co-authors for each submission. The author who makes the submission will be treated as the corresponding author unless otherwise noted.
3. Session organizers will notify corresponding authors about **acceptance of papers beginning on February 28, 2019**.
4. Completed papers should be sent to session organizers by May 15, 2019.
5. Students can submit their papers to any session. Those who submitted their papers to the Graduate Development Conference should send their papers to Eugena Kwon (ekwon22@uwo.ca). They will receive comments on their papers.

6. The Student Paper Competition:
 - Students' papers submitted to the regular sessions and the Graduate Development Conference are eligible for the Student Paper Competition.
 - Student authors who wish to submit their paper for the Competition should submit their abstract to the Student Competition Committee Co-chairs (Martin Cooke cooke@uwaterloo.ca & James Falconer james.falconer@Canada.ca) by January 31, 2019.
 - Full papers need to be submitted to the Student Competition Committee Co-chairs by April 19, 2019 in order to be considered for the Competition.

9. All participants must be current members of the Canadian Population Society to participate in the CPS meeting.
10. Please make note that at least one author of an accepted paper must **register for the conference by April 19, 2019**. Papers for which no author has registered by this deadline will be dropped from the final program. If you require an exemption from this policy (e.g., you are an international student/participant who is waiting for an approved visa or have other extenuating circumstances), please email the Organizing Committee Chair, Yoko Yoshida (yoko.yoshida@dal.ca) by April 5th.
