2. The author making the submission should provide the full names, affiliations, addresses, and e-mail addresses of all co-authors for each submission.
3. Authors will be notified by session organizers about acceptance of papers beginning on February 28th, 2017.
4. Completed papers should be sent to session organizers by May 15, 2017.
5. Student authors who wish to submit their paper for the Student Paper Competition should submit their abstract to both the session organizer and Yoko Yoshida (yoko.yoshida@dal.ca). Full papers need to be submitted to Yoko by April 3, 2017 in order to be considered for the Competition.
6. Students can submit their papers to any session. Those who submitted their papers to the Graduate Development Conference should send their papers to Yujiro Sano (ysano@uwo.ca). They will receive comments on their papers.
7. Authors who wish to submit their papers only for a poster session should submit their abstract directly to the Organizing Committee Chair, Lisa Strohschein (lisa.strohschein@ualberta.ca).
