

Procedures for Nomination:

The file for nominations should include the following materials: (1) a copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae; (2) a covering letter by the person making the nomination; (3) four signed letters of support of the nomination addressing the contributions to the body of knowledge made by the person being nominated. The person making the nomination and the nominated individual must be members of the Canadian Population Society. Self-nominations are accepted. In compelling cases, the Award may be given posthumously. Materials in support of the application must be received by the Awards Committee Chair before midnight on February 28th of the awarding year. The Awards Committee reserves the option of not recommending an award in any given competition.
